









## Call for Master 2 scholarships - 2025/2026 academic year

The « One Health - Emerging Infectious Diseases » Graduate School of Université Paris Cité aims to promote the internationalization of its Master's training program and help attract the best students from abroad and overseas. In this context, for the 2025-2026 academic year, we will finance incoming mobility scholarships of €10,000 each, awarded for the duration of one year.

The incoming mobility scholarships are for students wishing to pursue a Master 2 in Molecular and Cellular Biology – Emerging Infectious Diseases cursus (https://one-healtheid.u-paris.fr/en/master-en/).

The criteria for evaluating applications include:

- the solidity of the candidate's curriculum (biology, health, epidemiology/public health, veterinary sciences, engineering sciences),
- the candidate's strong motivation to join an interdisciplinary course,
- their interest in emerging infectious diseases\* and One Health approaches,
- their project and professional perspectives in this field.

For international students, applications must be submitted from **December 1, 2024 to January 17, 2025 by 17:00 CET**, on the following platform: <a href="https://mobility.smarts-up.fr/">https://mobility.smarts-up.fr/</a>

The preselected candidates will be <a href="mailto:interviewed">interviewed</a> between mid-February and mid-March and final rankings will be available at the beginning of April.

<u>Please note</u> that most non-European students living outside the EU are also required to register on the <u>Études en France</u> platform in parallel. This is a completely independent but necessary procedure to obtain a visa allowing to study in France.
